

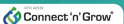

Connect 'n' Grow's VET in Schools story

- Providing training in schools for 10 years
- 100+ partner schools across Qld, NT & SA
- 20+ Health & Human Services Trainers across Qld & SA
- 400+ Indigenous students



Connect 'n' Grow's Pivot in the past 12 months

- In 2021 a Queensland Government agency announced a major change to how Vet in Schools must be delivered so that students could still access funding
- There were a large amount of impacted stakeholders including; RTO's, schools, students, trainers, admin staff
- It allowed minimal time to 'pivot' and we had to think innovatively to ensure we could still service students in regional areas and provide the same or better support
- **So, what did we did?**
 - Although we had no choice of the change, we had to be innovative with our solution
 - CrG developed a Hybrid delivery model that allowed us to still service majority of our existing schools
 - Regional based trainers

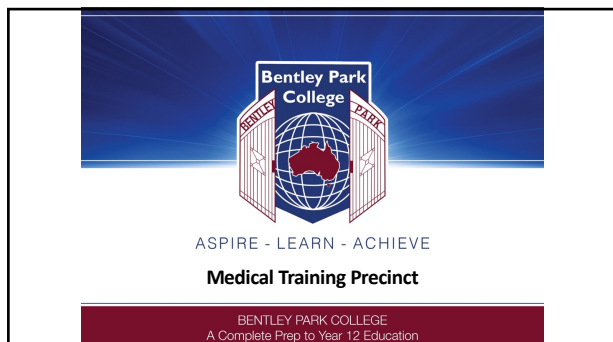

- Bentley Park College is a Prep to Year 12 school with 1675 students
- 40% of students identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander
- 7% Hmong refugee background
- 40% speak English as an additional language/ dialect
- Low ICSEA rating – 63% of students in the bottom quartile of socio-educational disadvantage

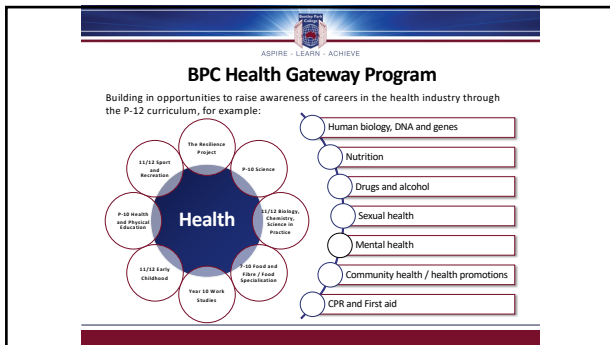


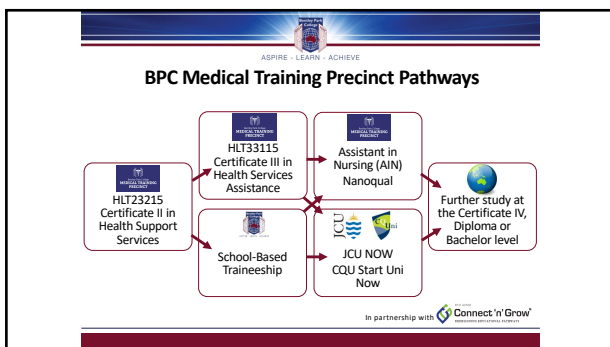
